MERABISHVILI OUT, EZHOKINA IN AS TWO RUSSIAN PIANISTS TRADE PLACES

Pianist **Nino Merabishvili**, originally scheduled for the March 2 Masterpiece Series concert, had to withdraw earlier this month for surgery on her wrist. Luckily, her friend and fellow Russian pianist **Oksana Ezhokina** is able to step in. It will be her first appearance at Second City. She is an artist in residence at the Icicle Creek Music Center in Leavenworth.

WILLIAM DOPPMANN, J. S. BACH IN SPOTLIGHT

J. S. Bach was renowned for his prowess at the keyboard as well as composition. Modern day composer-performers are more rare, but one significant exception is **SCCS co-founder William Doppmann**. With the premiere of his latest new work given here just last month, he returns on **Sunday, April 29** to the **Spotlight Series** as pianist in a spectacular solo tribute to **Bach**, performing Bach-inspired works by **Liszt** and **Dallapiccola**, as well as Bach's own astonishing **Goldberg Variations**. Doppmann, well known to SCCS audiences as a chamber musician and composer, is also internationally recognized as an orchestral soloist and recitalist. The *Washington Post* has called him, "a pianist giant." The April 29 concert is at **First Lutheran Church, Sixth Avenue & I Street, Tacoma, at 5:00 PM.** (Note the change in time.)
